He said he was my boyfriend... He treated me like a queen... He told me that he loved me... He drove me to a party...

He told me we needed to make money... He put my body up for sale... I didn't think I had a choice...

Now I know he doesn't love me, but I don't want to be on the streets alone.

It's called sex trafficking.

## **Sex Trafficking Warning Signs**

Sex trafficking is a form of modern-day slavery, forcing victims to exchange sexual acts for anything of value. Learn to recognize the signs of this serious crime and help save someone's life.



## Sex trafficking warning signs include:

- Running away from home
- Not attending school
- Having large amounts of cash or unexplained valuable items, such as cell phones or credit cards
- Dating someone significantly older
- Signs of physical abuse such as burn marks, bruises, or cuts
- New tattoos (traffickers often use tattoos as a form of branding)
