



Did you know?

- The OAG Victim Witness Unit is located at 441 4th Street NW (Judiciary Square) 11th floor Suite 1080 North.
- Free Daycare is available on site at DC Superior Court (C-185) for children ages 2-12 yrs old.
- Using metro is the easiest, most convenient way to get to court (parking is costly and limited). Red line (Judiciary square) or Green line (National Archives).
- Private rooms are available to victims who request not to be in the presence of the person(s) charged with the violation and their family members until it's time to testify.
- The JM level of DC Superior Court has a designated kid friendly area which shows family appropriate animated movies.
- You have the option of entering DC Superior Court through the side entrance directly next to Metropolitan Police Headquarters with proper Id.
- Juvenile trials are “closed” trials, which limits who is allowed into the courtroom. Excluding court staff, only victims, witnesses and immediate family members will be allowed access.
- All victims/witnesses who are required to testify will receive a \$40.00 witness fee through the Office of Finance for DC Superior Court.
- It is unlawful to speak to anyone regarding the matters discussed inside of the courtroom. Juvenile hearings are strictly confidential.
- Cell phones must be turned off inside of the courtroom or you will be subject to a fine or removal from the courtroom.
