Are we correct to assume that we are to sign and return Amendment A001 as part of our proposal and if so would it be acceptable if we changed the date in cell 9B of Page 1 from September 12, 2019 to September 30, 2019?</p>	<p>Please follow instructions in block 11 concerning amendments. Block 9B correctly cites the date of the <u>solicitation</u>. The date of the amendment is in block 3.</p>
<p>2. In regard to Q&A number 21, will it be acceptable to provide a list of subcontractors as an attachment to our completed Price Schedule?</p>	<p>Yes.</p>
<p>3. In regard to Q&A number 30: Should the vendor submit two pricing schedules to accommodate the different schedule hours?</p>	<p>No. We have added the alternative pricing for the shorter hours as option lines *001A and *002A in each year of the revised Pricing Schedule set forth on pages 4-7 of this amendment.</p>
<p>4. Can the vendor add the Collection to the pricing schedule so the Agency can determine which pricing schedule belongs to the collection schedule? Or is there another way that the vendor should identify the different pricing.</p>	<p>See response to Question 3 above.</p>
<p>5. In regard the new pricing schedule B.3.1Base Year CLIN 003 where the unit is listed as "Per Site or Special Project":</p> <p><i>(a) Is the Agency looking for an all-inclusive price here?</i></p> <p><i>(b) Can the vendor charge for the collection site <u>and</u> charge for each specimen collected that day?</i></p>	<p>Yes. The price for each Site or Special Project shall include set-up of all necessary equipment as specified in C.3.3.6 and staffing for up to eight (8) hours. (Average 5-6 hours)</p> <p>An Offeror may propose a price or "No Charge" or "Not Separately Priced" for the collection site and instead include the cost of the site set-up in the price for the specimen. (Some contractors charge the same price per collection regardless of where they are performing the services and do not charge an additional site fee.)</p>
<p>6. In regard to the new pricing schedule B.3.3 Option Year Two CLIN 2003 where the "Estimated Quantity" is listed as 525 and the Unit is listed as "Kits", based on the Q & A, this fee refers to staff/self-collections and testing. <i>Should the unit of measure actually be specimens instead of "Kits" to include the testing of the specimen? The industry standard is to include the cost of the kits for staff/self-collections along with the testing.</i></p>	<p>The Offeror is to enter the price for providing each Kit and Testing of each specimen collected in each Kit, whether staff or self-collected.</p>

<p>7. We were looking for more detail on the actual office set up for the additional collection sites you are wanting set up. We have done pop-up type facilities, and we have done permanent offices. Would this be more of the latter?</p>	<p>No, OAG is not seeking pricing for permanent facilities. The CSSD mobile team has events where they travel to different locations in an RV and offer testing.</p> <p>See response to Question 5.</p>
<p>8. Line numbers ending in n003, n004 and n005 in the Base year and Four Option Years are all listed as "Optional". Can the Agency provide guidance on which lines will be used to evaluate the lowest pricing? For example if a vendor doesn't offer pricing for 003, 004, 005 then their Total Estimated Amount For Base and Four Option Years could be considered lowest, but the Vendor did not provide pricing for all of the Services. Will the Optional price lines be considered when evaluating the lowest score?</p>	<p>As specified in Section M.4, "The District will evaluate offers for award purposes by evaluating the total price for all options as well as the base year. Evaluation of options shall not obligate the District to exercise them."</p> <p>THE DISTRICT WILL NOT ACCEPT OFFERS THAT DO NOT INCLUDE PRICES FOR THE OPTIONS.</p>
