

Q3. How many female team members will be participating in the gender focused group?

A3. There are currently 14 women employed with Cure The Streets. While they might not all participate in the monthly support groups, 14 will be the maximum number of participants.

Q4. SCA is listed as being incorporated into the HCA. Can consideration be given to an amendment to this to allow for the use of 1099 contractors versus employees?

A4. Contractors or consultants (as long as each is qualified) are acceptable to us if the agency they are contracting with has the ability to ensure consistency, i.e., each program will be served by a single clinician for the FY (unless unforeseen extenuating events or circumstances necessitate a change).
