## **FINDINGS**

## 1. **AUTHORIZATION:**

D.C. Official Code § 2-354.04, PPRA Section 404, 27 DCMR 5032

### 2. MINIMUM NEED:

The Office of the Attorney General Cure the Streets violence interruption program requires the contractor to continue to support the program by providing survey services. The contractor will conduct a second round of surveys as a follow up to the initial survey conducted under PO615283 using the same survey design.

#### 3. ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE:

\$30,000

#### 4. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:

- A. The contractor conducted an initial survey under a competitively awarded procurement. The scope of the original award to the contractor included a requirement to conduct a second survey. The second survey is meant to be a follow up to the baseline survey.
- B. The follow up survey is intended to be compared to the baseline survey to help measure whether Cure the Streets has impacted perceptions of community safety. It is therefore critical that the same contractor conduct both surveys—to ensure consistency in methodology and data points collected, so that data can be easily compared and conclusions drawn. Slight differences in methodology, or a lack of understanding of how the baseline survey was conducted, could render the surveys much less useful.
