**JUDGMENT**


For the reasons stated in the order issued this 13th day of December, 2021, granting the plaintiff's motion for summary judgment against defendant Fatoumata Bah, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that judgment is entered against Defendant Bah and in favor of the District of Columbia in the total amount of \$39,900; \$9,900 of which shall be deposited with the District of Columbia's Vulnerable Adult and Elderly Person Exploitation Restitution Fund (D.C. Code § 1-306.86d) for restitution to the Estates of F.W. and E.C., an amount for which defendant Bah is jointly and severally liable with any other defendant ordered to pay restitution in connection with this matter; and it is further

**ORDERED** that all professional licenses issued by the District of Columbia that enable Defendant Bah to work with elders or vulnerable adults be revoked; and it is further

**ORDERED** that Defendant Bah is permanently barred from future employment with elders or vulnerable adults.
