- I. <u>PURPOSE</u>: To advise CSSD personnel on the procedures for revoking an obligor's driver's license and/or registration for non-payment of child support. CSSD will determine if an obligor is in compliance with an order of support and evaluate whether the obligor is subject to the license and/or vehicle registration revocation.
- II. <u>REFERENCES</u>: D.C. Official Code § 46-225.01; 42 U.S.C. § 666(a)(16).
- III. <u>POLICY</u>: An obligor is non-compliant and eligible for revocation if (1) the obligor fails to comply with a subpoena or warrant relating to paternity or child support; or (2) if the obligor is receiving income and has child support that is at least 60 days in arrears and is not making payment in full for current support plus 25% of the current monthly child support obligation towards arrears. Upon a determination that the obligor is non-compliant with an order of support, CSSD will follow procedures to revoke the obligor's driver's license and/or vehicle registration.
